PEGASUS BAY ARABIANS LOCATED IN THE MISTY MOUNTAINS OF LE BONS BAY - BANKS PENINSULA

For those desirous of a wee challenge, **Saturday 22 January 2011** is respectfully suggested as being a reasonably convenient time. There will be no formalities, the stroll around the hills will be early afternoon, approx 1pm. Visitors are welcome to bring food to share, tea and coffee can most probably be arranged.

- take the highway to Akaroa
- upon reaching Hilltop take the Scenic Summit Road and continue for approx 30 minutes - any faster you are probably practising for the next rally
- by then you should have reached Le Bons Bay - you can only turn left
- 177 Le Bons Bay Road is Pegasus Bay Arabians (approx 2 km down), on the left
- as the horses are predominantly of Polish bloodlines there may be a Polish flag flying from the gatepost - the Polish flag is red and white
- vehicle parking up by the house is very limited - I suggest you carpool or walk on arrival

I can assure you of an invigorating experience. See you then.
